



## The Cobra Effect

- In colonial India, the British government wanted to reduce the number of cobras in Delhi, so it offered a bounty for dead cobras.
- Profit-seeking locals responded by breeding cobras to receive the bounty.
- What happens when we pay people to capture methane from cow manure?



### 70 of 91 CA Digesters Came Online Since 2019




Year Operational

## Value of Dairy Digesters is from Prevented Methane Emissions

- Digesters cost: \$1,130 per cow. Market value of gas: \$128 per cow.
- Social value of prevented methane emissions: \$420-\$1,300 per cow.
  - depending method of accounting for climate damages
- CA and federal fuel programs pay \$1,100-\$2,200 per cow




#### Costs and Benefits of Dairy Digesters: 2016-2023



## Dairy Cows Now Concentrated in Fewer States





## CA Dairy Herd Stopped Growing in 2007




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### Dairy Farms are Getting Bigger




Q: Did the digester boom cause consolidation in dairy farms?A: Trend in cows per farm accelerated in 2018, before the boom.




